I understand that my pet is tentatively scheduled to undergo the following procedure:

This procedure includes a general anesthetic and some risk is involved. This risk can be reduced by the recommended laboratory work up. Most anesthetic drugs are removed from the body by the liver and kidneys; therefore, it is important that these organs are healthy prior to anesthesia. It is also important that these patients have normal blood cell counts to promote proper tissue healing.

Laboratory work, before an anesthetic or surgery, can make us aware of unknown medical conditions that may make your pet a poor surgical risk or increase the chance of an adverse reaction to the anesthetic agent. However, if all the laboratory tests are normal, it does not guarantee that your pet will not have intra-operative adverse events, but it does tell us that your pet is in a lower risk category.

We offer EKG (electrocardiogram) evaluation prior to anesthesia to identify irregular heart rhythm (arrhythmia) via telecommunication with a board certified cardiologist. If an abnormality is evident the cardiologist will advise no surgery. A more detailed evaluation would be additional and recommended.

We offer a Coagulation Profile prior to surgery to evaluate the clotting function of your pet's blood to identify potential bleeding abnormalities that may impact your pet's recovery.

For the protection of all animals in the hospital we require that your pet is current on the following:

Canine vaccines are the following: Rabies, DHLPP-C, Bordetella, & Fecal.

Feline vaccines are the following: Rabies, FVRCP & Fecal.

A veterinarian must give these vaccines. If vaccines were given at another hospital, a proof of receipt is required; any vaccines found to be delinquent will be given at the owner's expense. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that Marietta Animal Hospital receives the proper vaccination receipts before admission into the hospital.

If your pet is in heat, pregnant, or has recently been nursing, there will be an additional charge to spay your animal, starting at \$30.00-\$60.00.

If your pet has a flea/tick infestation, it will be treated prior to surgery at the cost to the owner. \$14.00 - \$20.00.
