For the protection of all animals in the hospital, boarding animals **MUST** be current on vaccinations. If vaccinations were performed at another hospital, **A CERTIFICATE OR RECEIPT MUST BE PRESENTED UPON ADMISSION TO THE HOSPITAL. Any vaccinations found to be delinquent will be given at the owner's expense.** Required vaccines for canines are Rabies, Canine Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, and Leptospirosis. Required vaccines for felines are Rabies, Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, and Panleukopenia. We strongly advise Canine Influenza vaccine for all dogs boarding in the hospital. This vaccine is most effective if two boosters are given two to four weeks apart prior to staying in the hospital. Canine Influenza vaccine reduces severity and duration of disease.

Every attempt will be made to protect your pet from infectious disease through good sanitation policies and established isolation contagious disease protocols and guidelines. However, any situation that involves multiple animals in close proximity increases the risk of infectious disease. If your pet shows symptoms of a contagious disease it will be treated appropriately and isolated from the other patients and you will be responsible for any additional cost. If your pet shows signs of a contagious disease within one to two weeks of staying at Marietta Animal Hospital, we will waive the fee for a follow-up exam, but you will be responsible for the cost of treatment. If your pet shows illness more than two weeks after staying at Marietta Animal Hospital, you will be responsible for all cost incurred.

All animals must be free of all internal and external parasites (including fleas and ticks). Parasites will be treated appropriately. Costs range from \$14.00 – \$30.00.

If your pet has any medical condition noted upon arrival or during their stay with us, the doctor will proceed with a complete exam and any minor diagnostic tests necessary, which may include a fecal check, skin scrape, or ear swab. The doctor will prescribe medical treatment as indicated. Every attempt will be made to minimize diagnostics and treatments for "minor" conditions, as long as we feel it does not jeopardize your pets health or comfort. For more serious or involved medical conditions, diagnostics and treatment will be done as indicated and charges applied accordingly. We will make reasonable attempts to keep you informed and updated on your pets care and progress. We will give you treatment options whenever possible, however, you may not decline basic care for your pet.

I understand that Marietta Animal Hospital will make decisions about my pet's care and welfare based on my pet's best interest and I am responsible for all charges incurred at the time of discharge.

If your pet should injure itself in an escape attempt, become ill, or die while in the care of Marietta Animal Hospital, the hospital or the staff shall not be held responsible and/or liable in the absence of gross negligence.

Please inform the receptionist at the time your pet is admitted of any destructive behavior your pet may have. Marietta Animal Hospital is not responsible if your pet destroys and/or ingests towels, toys, and/or bowls; you will be responsible for the cost of care and treatment. Animals seen destroying towels, toys and/or bowls will not be given additional towels, toys, nor have bowls left in kennel. I understand that my pet is **not** under 24 hour supervision and if my pet should injure itself in an escape attempt, become ill, or die while in the care of Marietta Animal Hospital, I shall not hold the hospital or the staff responsible and/or liable in the absence of gross negligence.

Aggressive animals, which cannot be safely handled by our staff, will not be allowed to board at Marietta Animal Hospital. If your pet becomes aggressive during it's stay, to the degree that we cannot provide the necessary quality of care without placing our employees at an extraordinary risk of injury, the emergency contact given above will be contacted to pick-up your pet. You may also be charged an extra handling fee due to your pet's aggressive behavior, and your pet will not be able to board at Marietta Animal Hospital in the future.

We require 24 hour advanced notice if your animal will be boarded beyond the date specified upon admission. If you do not pick up your pet or contact us within 10 days after the designated date of discharge, your pet will be considered abandoned. You will still be financially responsible for all services rendered.

All animals are kept in separate, comfortable, clean, indoor, climate-controlled boarding quarters. We supply towels, litter boxes, food and water. Animals are given fresh water and put in clean kennels twice daily. Canines are walked twice daily. Canines are fed once daily in the AM, unless a medical condition requires a different schedule. Felines are feed twice daily.

IF YOUR PET STAYS OVERNIGHT, WE WILL PROCEED WITH A BATH PRIOR TO DISCHARGE (SEE COSTS AT BOTTOM OF PAGE). IF YOU NEED TO CHANGE YOUR PICK UP DATE, YOU MUST GIVE 24 HOUR ADVANCE NOTICE OR YOU MAY BE CHARGED FOR AN ADDITIONAL BATH.

Please call prior to picking up your pet to make sure your pet is dry and ready for discharge after its bath.
